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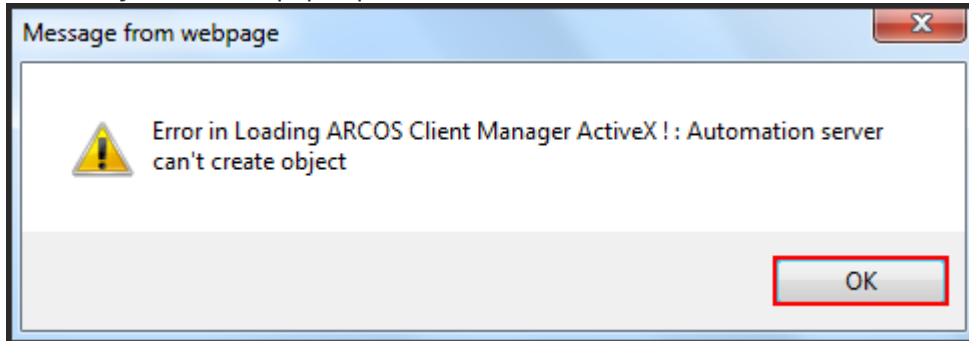
1 Prerequisites

The prerequisites for **ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX** are as follows:

- Microsoft .Net Framework 2.0
- ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX

2 Installing ActiveX

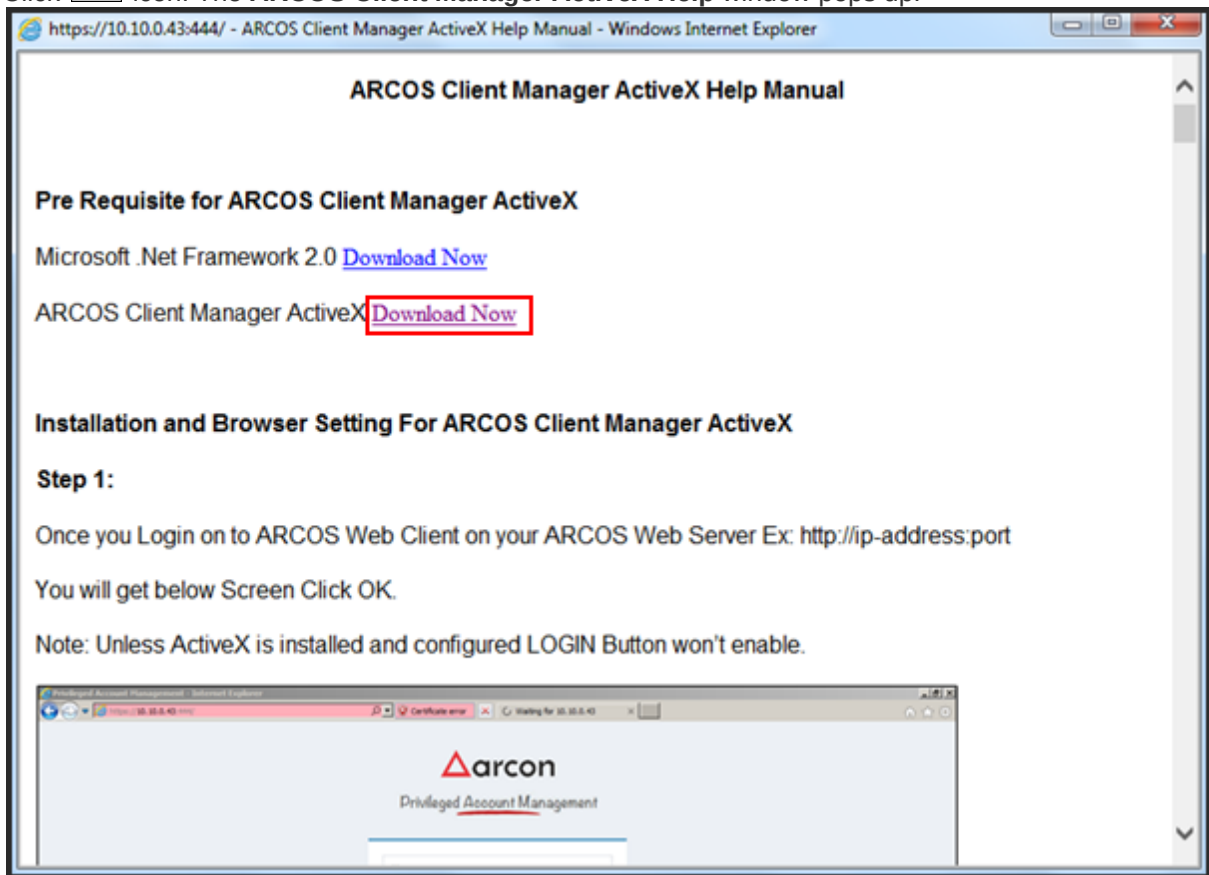
1. Enter the **URL** <<http://ip-address:port>> in the address bar.
2. The **Message 'Error in Loading ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX !: Automation server can't create object'** window pops up.



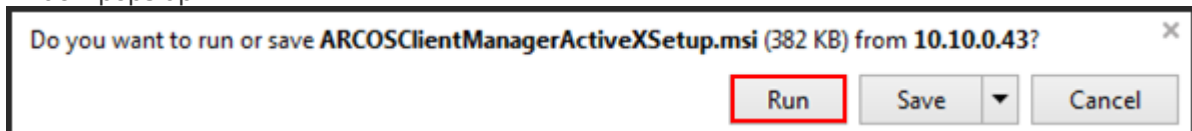
3. Click **OK** button. The **ARCON** login screen is displayed



- 4. Click  icon. The **ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX Help** window pops up.

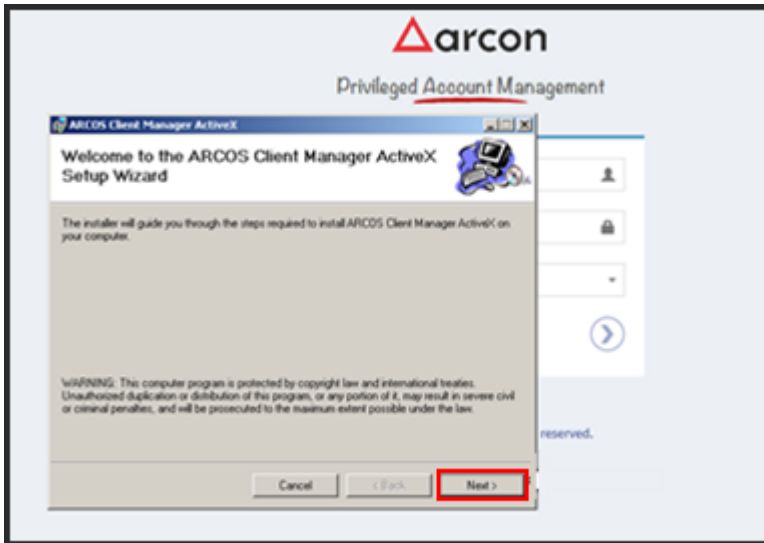


- 5. Click the **ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX Download Now** link.
- 6. A message 'Do you want to run or save ARCOSClientManagerActiveXSetup.msi (382 KB)?' window pops up.

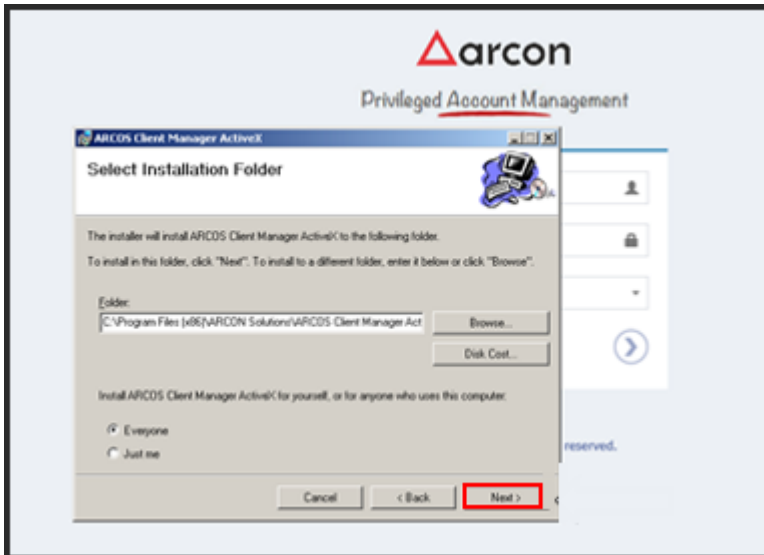


- 7. Click **Run** button. The **ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX Setup Wizard** window pops up.

- 8. Click **Next** button.

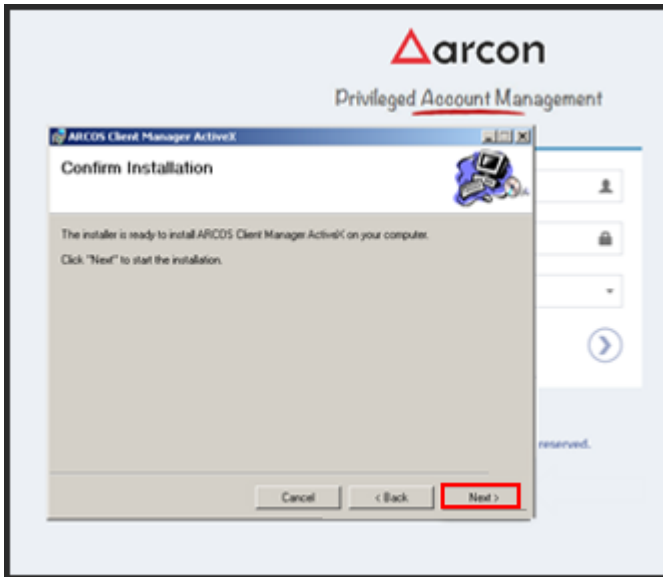


- 9. The **ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX** window pops up for selecting the installation folder.
- 10. Click **Next** button.

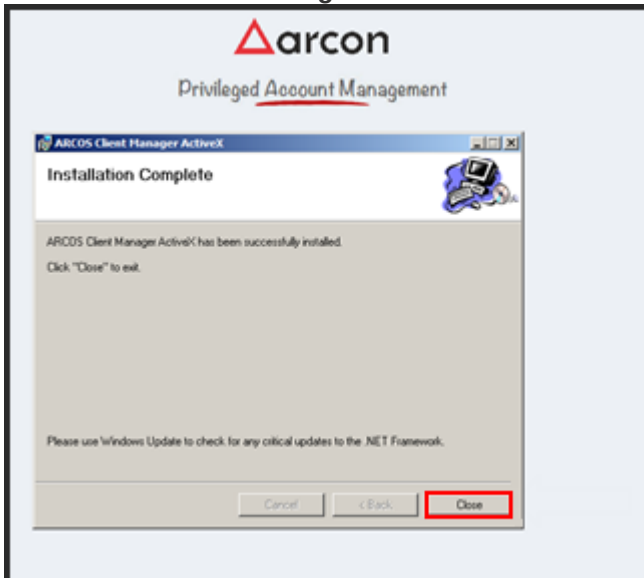


- 11. The **ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX** window for confirming installation pops up.

- 13. The **ARCOS Client Manager ActiveX** window for successfully completing the installation pops up.



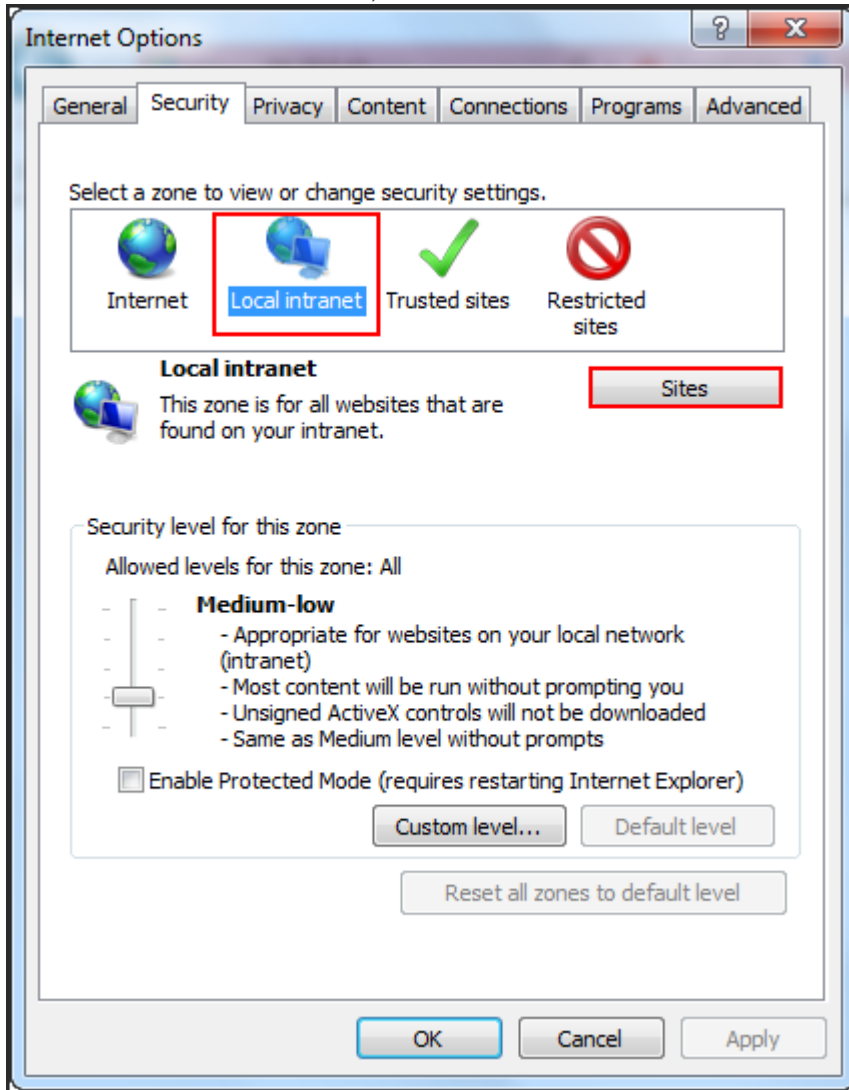
- 14. Click **Close** button to successfully complete the installation of ActiveX Client Manager.

 The login button is enabled, when **ActiveX** is installed successfully in your system.

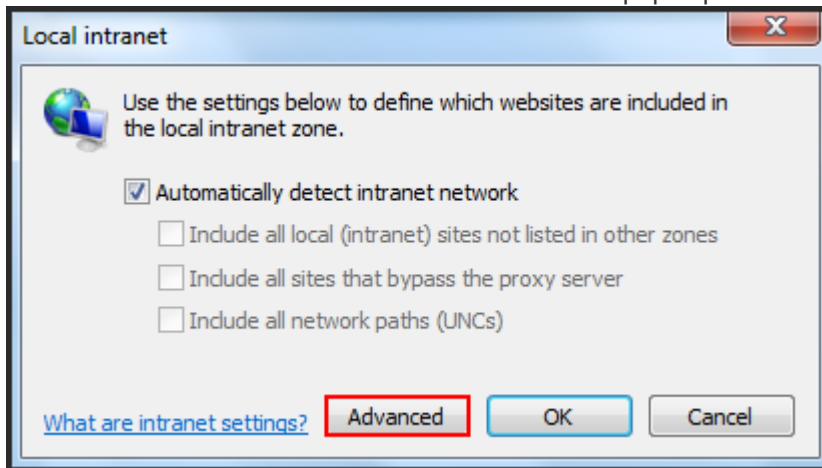
3 Configuring ActiveX

When ActiveX is installed, you have to configure it. To configure ActiveX follow the below steps.

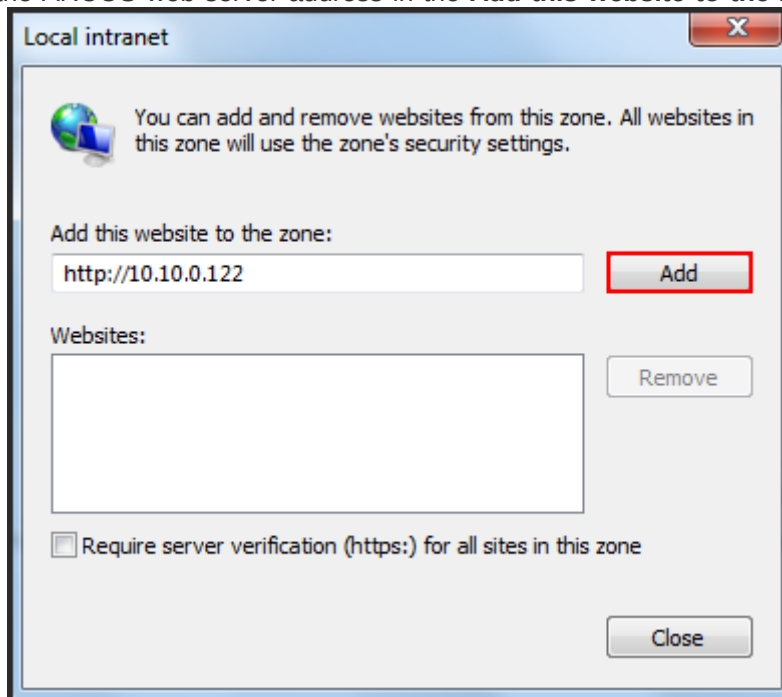
1. Refresh the **ARCOS login** page in your Internet Explorer browser.
2. Go to **Tools Internet Options Security tab**
3. Click **Local intranet** icon, click **Sites** button. A Local intranet window pops up.



4. Click **Advanced** button. The **Local intranet** window pops up.

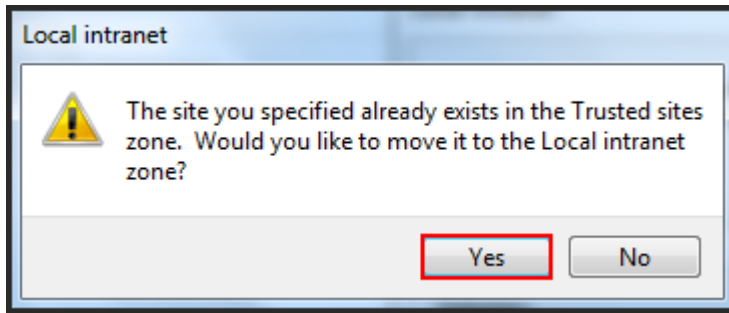


5. Enter the ARCOS web server address in the **Add this website to the zone** text field and click **Add**

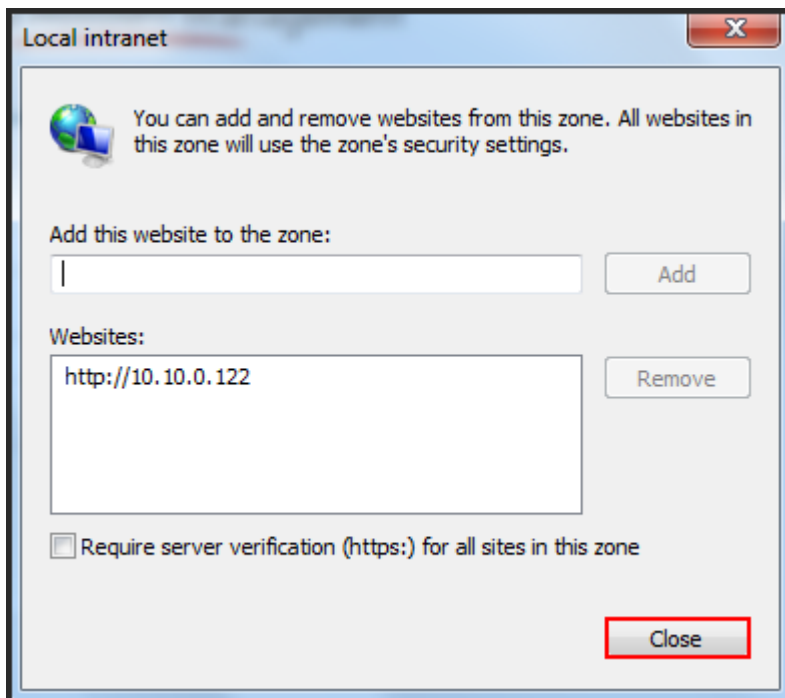

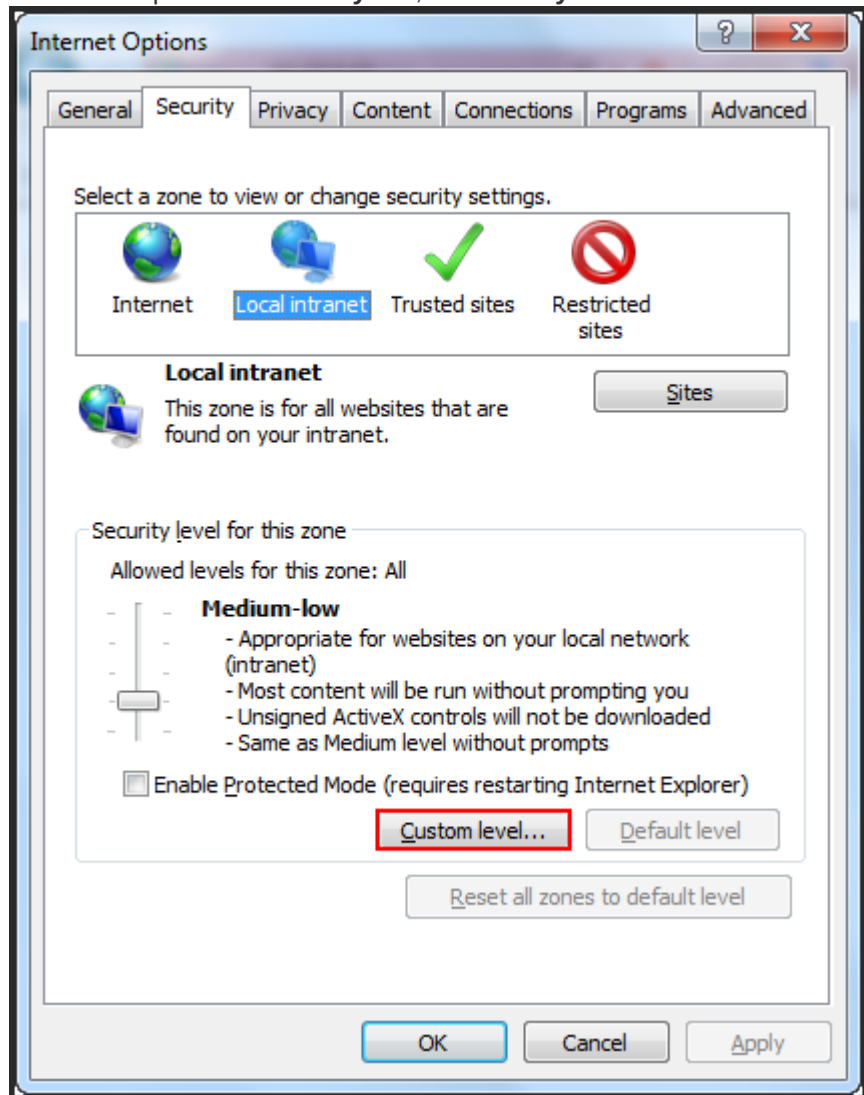
6. A Local intranet message window **'The site you specified already exists in the Trusted sites zone. Would you like to move it to the Local intranet zone?'** pops up.
7. Click **Yes** button.



- 8. The website address is added in the **Websites** text area.
- 9. Click **Close** button to close the Local intranet window.

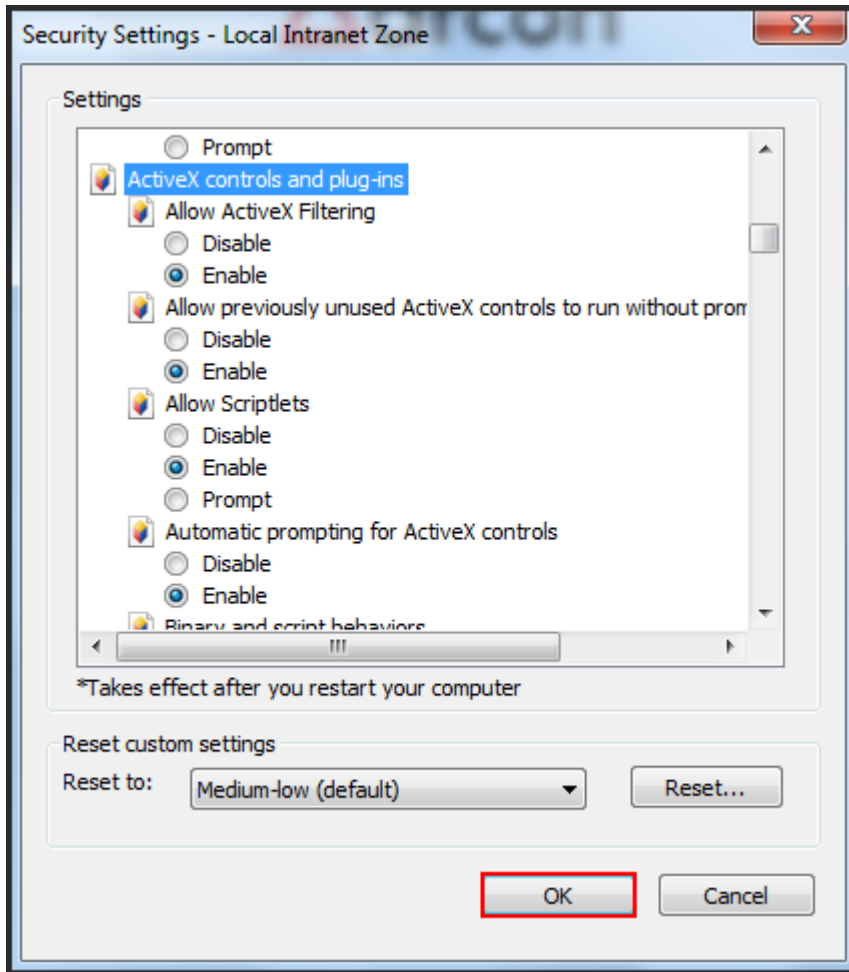


10. The **Internet Options** window is still open. On **Security** tab, in **Security level for this zone** area,

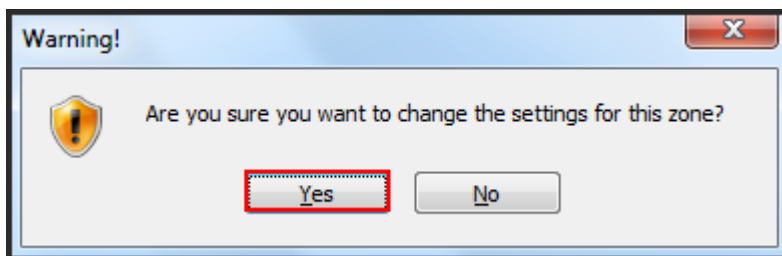


click **Custom Level** button.

- 11. The **Security Settings – Local Intranet Zone** window pops up.
- 12. In **Settings** area, select all the **Enable** radio button under **ActiveX controls and plug-ins** and click **OK** button.





13. A **Warning** 'Are you sure you want to change the settings for this zone' window pops up.



14. Click **Yes** button to successfully change the settings of the Local intranet.



 ActiveX is installed and configured successfully, refresh the login page of ARCOS Client Manager and you can see the **Login**  button is active.

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
